## Part 1 - Rebellion

*1:15<sup>b</sup> Your hands are full of blood! 16 Wash and make yourselves clean.*

Israel rejected God and lived self-centered lives at the expense of the marginalized. Isaiah warns them to return, or be disciplined.

## Part 2 - Exile

*43:2 When you pass through the waters, I will be with you*

God sends Babylon to enslave Israel in order to break them of their arrogant self-dependency, leading them back to the Lord.

## Part 3 - Rescue

*61:1<sup>b</sup> He has sent me to bind up the broken-hearted, to proclaim freedom for the captives and release from darkness for the prisoners,*

God rescues and renews Israel from “death,” all pointing to Jesus who does this for us.

<sup>4</sup> Ah, sinful nation, a people laden with iniquity,  
offspring of evildoers, children who deal corruptly!

They have forsaken the LORD  
they have despised the Holy One of Israel,  
they are utterly estranged.

<sup>5b</sup>The whole head is sick, and the whole heart faint.


<sup>11</sup> “What to me is the multitude of your sacrifices?” says the LORD;

and the fat of well-fed beasts;  
I do not delight in the blood of bulls, or of lambs, or of goats.

<sup>13</sup> Bring no more vain offerings;  
incense is an abomination to me.

        they shall become like wool.

<sup>19</sup> If you are willing and obedient,  
you shall eat the good of the land;  
<sup>20</sup> but if you refuse and rebel,  
you shall be eaten by the sword;  
for the mouth of the LORD has spoken.”

*1:2b “Children have I reared  
and brought up,*

*but they have rebelled against me.*

# How We Live Estranged: Both Near and Far

*<sup>4</sup> Ah, sinful nation, a people

*<sup>5b</sup>The whole head is sick,  
and the whole heart faint.*



## Estranged: Me > Others

<sup>15</sup> When you spread out your hands,  
I will hide my eyes from you;  
even though you make many prayers,  
I will not listen;  
***your hands are full of blood.***

To the extent that I am disconnected from God and His Gracious Love, I enthrone myself and use others for ***my own benefit***

# Estranged: Worship Façade

<sup>13</sup> Bring no more **vain** offerings;  
incense is an abomination to me.  
New moon and Sabbath and the  
calling of convocations—  
I cannot endure iniquity  
and solemn assembly.

<sup>14</sup> Your new moons and your  
appointed feasts my soul hates;  
they have become a burden to me;  
I am weary of bearing them.

<sup>15</sup> When you spread out your hands,  
I will hide my eyes from you;  
even though you make many  
prayers, I will not listen;  
**your hands are full of blood.**

Worship for **my own**  
**benefit**...cultural and personal  
obligation, chasing a spiritual high.

Outward Piety,  
Inward Corruption

## Matthew 23:23

“Woe to you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! For you tithe mint and dill and cumin, and have neglected the weightier matters of the law: justice and mercy and faithfulness. These you ought to have done, without neglecting the others.

*“I am my own master.  
Everything and Everyone,  
including God and church,  
exist to please me”*

- Church is checking my spiritual box.
- How did the service make me feel?



So God simply gives us what we ask...he says “OK. Your will be done”

<sup>19</sup> If you are willing and obedient,  
you shall eat the good of the land;

<sup>20</sup> ***but if you refuse and rebel,***

***for the mouth of the LORD has spoken.”***

For Us:  
Exile to Sin, Fear and Death

# How to Be Re-Connected

<sup>18</sup> Come now, let us **reason** together, says the LORD:  
though your sins are like scarlet,  
they shall be as white as snow;  
though they are red like crimson,  
they shall become like wool.

“Reason” – “lets get real...you’re broken and I’ve got the cure.”  
“come to your senses” (Luke 15)

# How to Be Re-Connected

Are: Scarlet & Crimson

Shall Be: Snow & Wool

<sup>5</sup> But he was pierced for our transgressions;  
he was crushed for our iniquities;  
upon him was the chastisement that brought us peace,  
and with his wounds we are healed.
