


Jesus is correcting their false interpretation of God's Law, which:


Made The Law about behavior

Matthew 5:27-32

Our deepest longing it to KNOW and to BE KNOWN

But NO, marriage is not the ultimate! Many are called to NOT be married so that their true intimacy will be reserved solely for Jesus

"and they shall become one flesh."

Commitment Leads to Intimacy We are designed to be simultaneously knit together as one: Emotionally, Physically, Spiritually


"Trying to get sexual pleasure to fill our fundamental yearning for human happiness is a recipe for disappointment." Rebecca DeYoung

Psalm 51

The point is NOT to behavior, but behavior absolutely reflect belief and impacts lives.

1 Thessalonians 4:3
