Are grapes gathered from thornbushes, or figs from thistles? ¹⁷ So, every healthy tree bears good fruit, but the diseased tree bears bad fruit. ¹⁸ A healthy tree cannot bear bad fruit, nor can a diseased tree bear good fruit. ¹⁹ Every tree that does not bear good fruit is cut down and thrown into the fire. ²⁰ Thus you will recognize them by their fruits.

Bad Fruit

Why and How:

The point is not WHAT we do, but WHY and by WHOSE POWER we do it:

"Inwardly are ravenous wolves"

Bad Fruit



Love – upward and outward Humble Repentance

Realize that I need to be saved from sin, and rest in the Finished Work of Christ

Galatians 5:22-26

But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, ²³ gentleness, self-control; against such things there is no law. ²⁴ And those who belong to Christ Jesus have crucified the flesh with its passions and desires.

²⁵ If we live by the Spirit, let us also keep in step with the Spirit. ²⁶ Let us not become conceited, provoking one another, envying one another. We live outward

Our old-inward has been crucified with Jesus

Our new lives are empowered by the Spirit, not by our own strength.

Why: Natural Response:

1 John 4:8 "We love because he first loved us"

How: The Holy Spirit loving through me

"the fruit **OF** the Spirit"

We are a Bowl of Mixed Fruit

Romans 7:14-15, 21

For we know that the law is spiritual, but I am of the flesh, sold under sin. ¹⁵ For I do not understand my own actions. For I do not do what I want, but I do the very thing I hate. ²¹ So I find it to be a law that when I want to do right, evil lies close at hand.²² For I delight in the law of God, in my inner being, ²³ but I see in my members another law waging war against the law of my mind and making me captive to the law of sin that dwells in my members. ²⁴ Wretched man that I am! Who will deliver me from this body of death? ²⁵ Thanks be to God through Jesus Christ our Lord!

Theo-logical

John 5:39–40 "You search the Scriptures because you think that in them you have eternal life; and it is they that bear witness about me, yet you refuse to come to me that you may have life."

Theo-emotional

John 4:23

But the hour is coming, and is now here, when the true worshipers will worship the Father in spirit and truth, for the Father is seeking such people to worship him.

Theo-relational

- Knowing About God, as revealed in all of Scripture
- Knowing the Heart of God, as exemplified on the Cross
 - Engaging the Life of God in our everyday life

Painfully Unsettling

This passage causes us to ask if our faith is merely religious moralism or spiritual emotionalism...and if we truly KNOW Jesus.

Warmly Comforting

This passage also assures us that, on our best and our worst days, the Gospel is enough because Jesus has paid the full price for mutual abiding.

How do I KNOW God?

Philippians 3:8 Indeed, I count everything as loss because of the surpassing worth of knowing Christ Jesus my Lord.

John 15:4-10 (excerpts)

Abide in me, and I in you. As the branch cannot bear fruit by itself, unless it abides in the vine, neither can you, unless you abide in me. ⁵ I am the vine; you are the branches. Whoever abides in me and I in him, he it is that bears much fruit, for apart from me you can do nothing. Groot Clip
